Policy discussion: We hold at least one Policy Day each year for members and others to discuss the progressive housing policies needed across the country. LHG branches in London, the North West and the North East, and elsewhere also hold their own events.

Influence: We are Labour's only housing-focused affiliate and we represent LHG members' views to the Front Bench. We attend Annual Conference and hold our own Fringe meetings there and at other conferences.

Campaigning: Campaigns include ending Assured Shorthold Tenancies, building council houses, leasehold reform, and promoting reform of land and planning policy.

Publications: LHG has published highly-regarded books such as *Right to a Home* and *The Roof Over Your Head*, and currently produces housing manifestos, pamphlets and policy briefings on a wide range of topics.
