Key facts about the current housing crisis

The Tories called their last Green Paper on housing "Fixing the Broken Housing Market". It is very much broken, but their policies have made matters worse in almost every way:

- Since 2010 Conservative Ministers have built fewer homes than any government, Labour or Conservative had since 1923
- The Tories have built only about 50,000 Council or Housing Association homes in the last 5 years (compared with Labour's 142,000 social rented homes in our last 4 years in government)
- The Conservative and Coalition Governments have failed to deliver a single new starter home despite promising to build 200,000 by 2020
- ♦ 80% of housing investment is now spent on home ownership
- Nouse prices have risen by 76% since 1995
- ♦ 134% rise in rough sleepers between 2010 and 2018
- 726 homeless people died on the streets or in temporary accommodation in England and Wales in 2018
- 60% rise in numbers of households in temporary accommodation;
 120,000 children are in temporary accommodation; Councils spent
 £93.3 million on Bed & Breakfast for homeless families in 2017-18
- The Housing Benefit bill was £23.4billion in 2018-9
- **♦ 3.4m** 20-34 year olds are **still living with parents**
- Private sector rents have gone up by 3 times wages since 2010, and private renting is unaffordable for working families on low wages in two thirds of the country
- Right To Buy has led to more than 1.8 million council homes being sold in Great Britain since 1980 – but more than 40% of council houses sold are now privately rented

What will Labour do to solve the housing crisis?

"Only Labour has a plan to fix the housing crisis. We will act on every front to bring the cost of housing down and standards up, so that everyone has a decent, affordable place to call home." It's time for Real Change, Labour Party Manifesto 2019

- 1. **Build an average of 155,000 public rented homes** each year. At least 100,000 of these will be council homes. This will help our plan to tackle the root causes of homelessness, and to end rough sleeping within 5 years
- 2. Introduce a £1bn Fire Safety Fund to fit sprinklers and other fire safety measures in all high-rise council and housing association tower blocks, and enforce the replacement of dangerous Grenfell-style cladding on all high-rise homes and buildings
- 3. **Abolish Assured Shorthold Tenancies** and make all tenancies indefinite private tenants will no longer have to move every 6 months or every year
- 4. **Introduce rent caps and rent controls**, so that no-one will have to pay more than one third of their earnings on their rent
- 5. **End the** *Right to Buy a*nd the forced conversion of social rented homes to so-called 'affordable rent'
- 6. **Abolish the Bedroom Tax** (which punishes tenants for any spare bedrooms)
- 7. **Reform the leasehold system** and give leaseholders the right to buy their freeholds
- 8. **Establish a new English Sovereign Land Trust**, with powers to buy land more cheaply for low-cost housing
- 9. **Set up a new Decent Homes programme** to improve public rented housing
- 10. Set up a zero-carbon homes standard for all new homes and upgrade millions of existing homes to make them energy efficient (and create hundreds of thousands of green jobs)



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
